- SITREP for Towns and Counties within the State of Connecticut. ("county reports")

The state has 8 Counties and 169 towns within its borders.

- Each county throughout the county has it own code.
- Connecticut has 8 counties: State Code: 09

You can also list the town (such as Plainville, CT, part of Hartford county (09003), The Time of

the report, The status of the following 7 conditions;

a) Power Status, Yes or No Power, Limited Power, or Normal Power;

b) Water - Yes or No Water supply or you may report some malfunction? What's the issue?

c) Sanitation System; Again you can use the Yes or No answer or if a issue what is it?

d) Medical; Yes or No-What is the problem (hospitals?)

e) <u>Communications</u>; Yes or No or some type of issues - You can report Cell, landline, Local PD, Fire, Ambulance, Describe what is reported.

f) <u>Transportation</u>; Roads, rail, Mass Transit, Another Yes or No for operation or not. If Issues, what are they?

g) How did you obtain your information, Eyewitness – you saw it, Commercial Broadcast, Scanner, Local government official, Do not report hearsay

Many different agencies can use this information

A sample version of that report body:

Plainville is the Town, The County is Hartford, the date and time in UTC when it is being reported. The month is in your header of the NTS Message.
